### 6.2 Non-Resident Accommodation Levy

1. It is not compulsory to stay at the university hostels, however a levy will be charged for players who choose to stay at non accredited accommodation.
2. All accredited accommodation will be booked through the LOC. Accredited accommodation are:
  - 2.1 University of Johannesburg Hostels
  - 2.2 Guest houses and other accommodation listed on the official web site.
  - 2.3 Should you wish to have accommodation accredited, please forward the details to the LOC and we will negotiate with the institution to accredit the accommodation.
3. The LOC will charge a once off R150 levy to players who do not stay in the hostels or at any of the accredited guest houses or accommodation listed on the official web site.
4. Accompanying persons do not have to pay the levy. Players and only players have to pay the levy.

### 6.3 Payment Arrangements

1. Estimated quantities for participation and accommodation must be submitted by 2010/09/30.
2. A non-refundable deposit must be paid by 2010/10/05. The deposit is 30% of the estimated quantity of participation and accommodation.
3. Final participation quantities must be submitted by 2010/10/25. The quantities supplied by this date will be used as a minimum billing quantity amount i.e. the union will be billed for this quantity or more. If no final quantity is supplied by 2010/10/25, the estimated quantity will be used as the final billing quantity.
4. All fees must be paid in full before 2010/11/20.
5. All late payments will incur a 5% penalty and interest at prime interest rate, calculated on a daily basis.
6. No occupation of the accommodation or participation will be allowed unless the account is settled in full upfront.

7. No accommodation will be guaranteed if the accommodation is not paid in full by the due date. The LOC reserves the right to reallocate any accommodation should the due dates not be adhered to.
8. All bookings of the facilities of the university must be booked through the LOC. Unions are not allowed to book any of the facilities of the University of Johannesburg in their own private capacity. The LOC will charge the union R60.00 pp per night for each booking at the university facilities not booked through the LOC.
9. Accommodation will also be made available to parents and friends on site.
10. Allocation of the accommodation facilities are done at the sole discretion of the LOC.
11. Refunds will only be paid out after a reconciliation of all accounts have been done which will not be later than 28 February 2011.
12. Unions must inform the LOC by no later than 2010/11/20 of players not staying in staying in accredited hostels. After 2010/11/20 the Non-Resident Accommodation Levy will be non refundable.

## 7. Accommodation

We will make use of accommodation on site. All hostels are within walking distance from the playing venue. Where possible the LOC will provide for special dietary requirements.

After the Team Event, all players resident in hostels will be required to move to one hostel. The union that first pays all it fees in full, will retain the right to stay in this hostel from the start of the competition.

## 9. Information Management

## 11. Registration software

Initial registrations will be completed within a spread sheet. The spread sheet will be sent to unions and available on the website by 2010/09/24. All registrations must be done via the spreadsheet. This includes registering players for the Individual Championships, Team Championships, Managers & Coaches and Non Resident Accommodation Levy, etc.

## 12. Arbiters

All applications must be made by downloading the application form from the [CHESSA](http://CHESSA) website. Once the deadline has passed, the names of those applicants will be forwarded to the ATM for ratification. ONLY names registered this way will be considered.

## 13. Trophies

Winners of 2009 SAJCC are kindly requested to return all trophies in their possession and also to please inform us who has which trophies. The deadline for notification is 2010/09/30. Trophies must be handed in during registration on Saturday 2010/12/11.

## 14. Name Cards

Regions must make their own ID cards for players, managers & coaches.

1. The LOC will provide a facility to laminate ID cards at the venue.
2. Hostel residents will get a sticker on their ID card, supplied by the LOC during registration.
3. Players and accompanying persons who paid for lunches will get a sticker on their ID cards, provided by the LOC during registration.
4. Requirements for ID cards are:
  - 4.1 The size is the same dimensions as that of a driver's license or credit card.
  - 4.2 Must have a picture (head & shoulder) of the person.
  - 4.3 Must contain the following information:
    - 4.3.1 Regional name (e.g. Western Province)
    - 4.3.2 Player name (e.g. John Doe). Please note, NO NICKNAMES.
    - 4.3.3 CHESSA Membership number
    - 4.3.4 Team name and board position (if participating in the Team Championships) (e.g. Board 4, Reserve 1, etc.).
    - 4.3.5 Must be in black printed letters.

Electronic clocks will have preference. Unions should stipulate the type of electronic clocks that they will bring along. **NO DIGIBLITZ CLOCKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

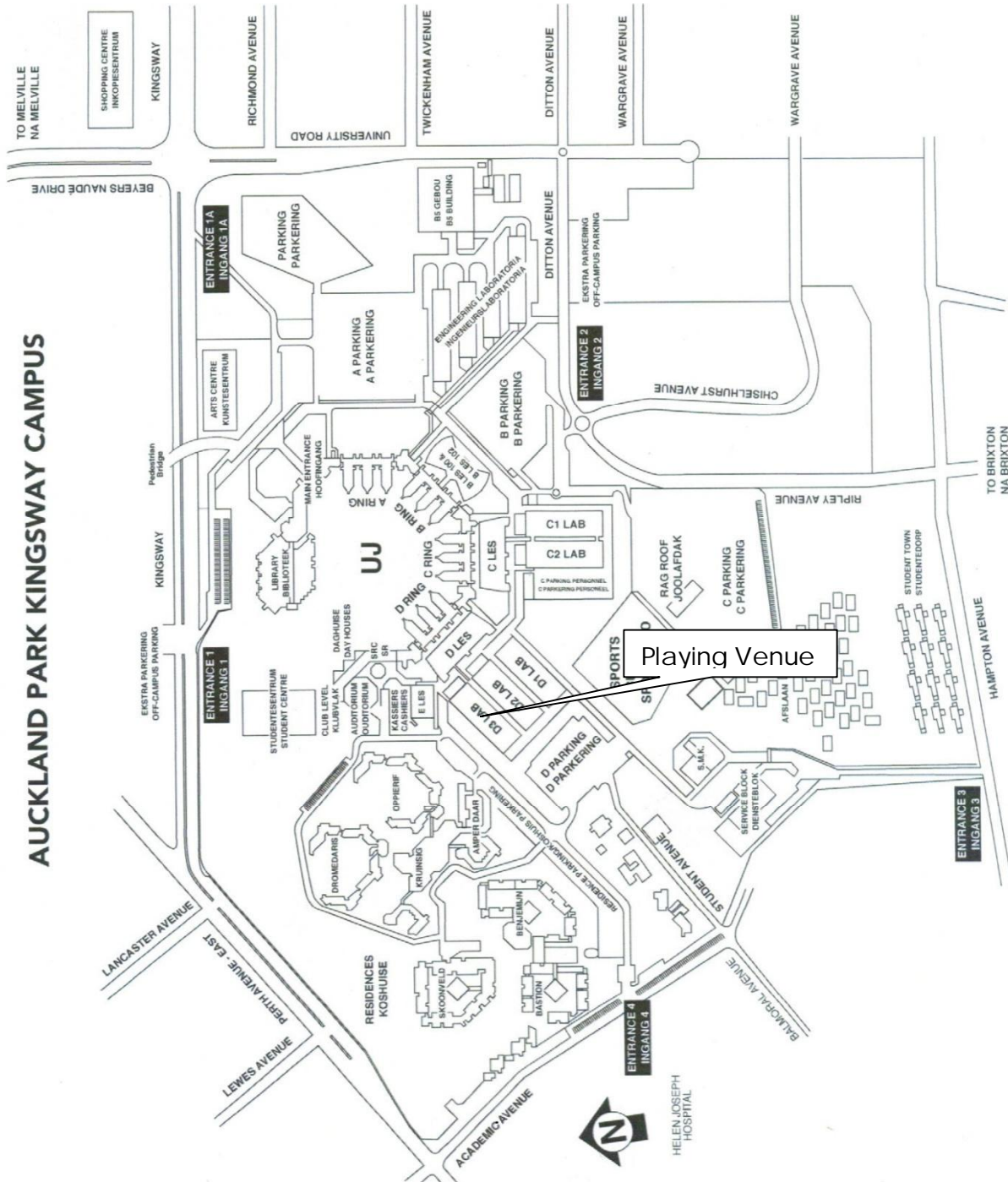
